Kathy or Bellevue, graduated from the University of Washington. She is an account manager at Wall Data.

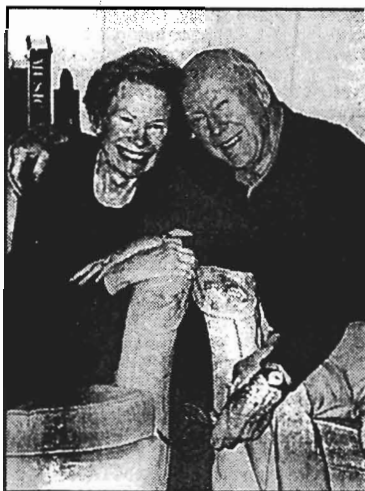
