When she entertains informally at home, she favors Mexican dishes.

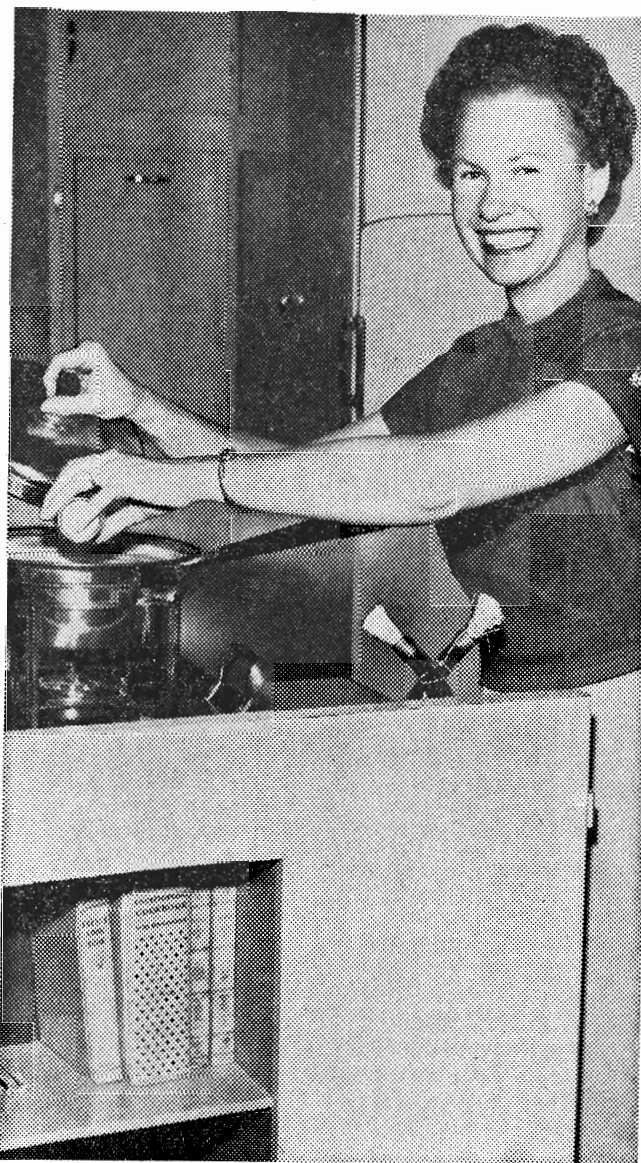
A favorite is Chili Con Queso.

Combine $\frac{1}{2}$ pound cheddar cheese (chopped in small pieces), 1 can green chili, 1 clove of garlic, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup cream; 1 small minced onion. Heat slowly and pour over Tostados-tortillas cut into pieces and fried in deep fat and salted.

This meal is complete when served with a tossed green salad and a tangy fruit dessert.
