

**Jessie Waln, East
Iowa Teacher, Dies**

Jessie Cartano Waln, widow of John Waln, 1637 Sixth street NW, died Sunday following a brief illness. Born May 31, 1887, at Springville, she had been a resident of Marion and Cedar Rapids since 1956.

Surviving are three sisters, Bessie Peterson of Council Bluffs, Lillian Rupp of Denver, and Marie Kerns of Cedar Rapids.

Mrs. Waln was a teacher in the Cedar Rapids area over 40 years, having taught in rural schools and in the grade schools at Tipton, Marengo, Reinbeck, Traer and at Taylor school in Cedar Rapids. Her last 24 years of teaching were spent in West Liberty elementary school. She also taught a year in Alaska. Mrs. Waln was a member of the Presbyterian church at Springville, a member of Love Chapter OES at Springville, the Cary club and Women's club of Marion and the Iowa Teachers Assn.
